Take six School of Continuing Studies courses and get the seventh free

frequently asked questions

Q: When do I receive my free class?

A: a three-credit undergraduate School of Continuing Studies course will be credited to your Accounts Receivable balance approximately three weeks after the approval date of that semester.

Q: What do I need to do to receive the seventh class free?

A: When you enroll for courses in the School of Continuing Studies, you are automatically included in the program, but you must fill out an application to request a seventh class free.

Q: Do my classes still count in the program if I pay tuition with financial aid?

A: Yes, but you need to check with Financial Aid to see if the free class award affects your financial aid package.

Q: Do classes offered by other Tulane schools count towards the free course?

A: Yes, as long as it is an undergraduate course of three or more credits. However, the maximum amount credited to your account is for the cost of one School of Continuing Studies three-credit course regardless of the cost of the class.

Q: Must I pass all six classes before they count towards the seventh free?

A: No. However, classes for which you have officially withdrawn and received the grade W will not count toward the seventh class free.

Q: Does this offer apply to student activity or lab fees?

A: No.

Q: Do I have to be enrolled every semester to stay in the program?

A: No. You do not have to enroll in consecutive academic terms.

Q: How many free classes can I have?

A: As long as the program continues, every time you have paid for any six classes you may receive a seventh class for free. You may not receive more than one free class at a time. There will be no retroactive credit allowed, and no more than one class per semester may be credited.

Q: Who is eligible for the program?

A: All part-time School of Continuing Studies students.

Q: Are Tulane employees eligible for the seventh class free?

A: No, unless the employee is paying for classes above the amount allowed by the waiver policy. In this case, employees must provide adequate records to show they paid for six classes. Family members of employees are not eligible for the seventh class free.

Q: When did this program begin?

A: The program began on January 1, 2000, and includes all courses taken after that date.
