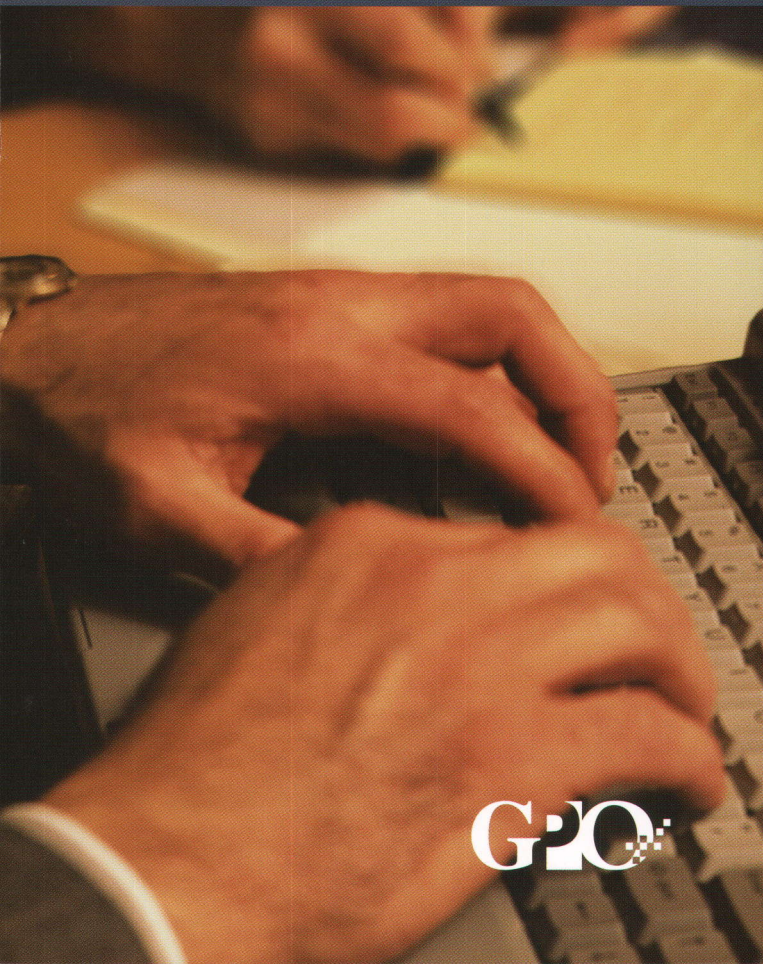

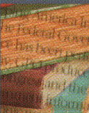

In addition to its full-text databases, *GPO Access* acts as a portal to information located throughout Federal Government Web sites and Federal depository libraries located nationwide. Use the various search and browse tools to:



1. Find Federal publications in print and electronic formats;
2. Locate Federal depository libraries that are likely to include that publication in their collection;
3. Locate publications available for purchase from the Superintendent of Documents.



## **Catalog of U.S. Government Publications**

Find print and electronic Government information products created by Federal agencies. Use it to link to Federal agency online resources, identify materials distributed to Federal depository libraries, and locate publications available for sale from the Superintendent of Documents.

## **Search the Federal Government**

Locate information on *GPO Access* and throughout the Federal Government using a search index provided by USA.gov. Options include the ability to search for information throughout the Federal Government or restrict searches to only *GPO Access* resources.

## **Depository Library in your Area**

Locate a Federal depository library in your area. These libraries are located throughout the United States and provide access to Federal information both in print and electronic formats. Expert library staff are available to assist users at these depository libraries.

## **Browse Topics**

Browse Topics is your pathway to Federal Web sites. Professional librarians from the Federal depository library community have created a browseable list of Federal Web sites based off broad subject areas. Choose a category and then click on a listing to read a detailed description of the services provided by a site. Brought to you in partnership with Oklahoma State University (OSU).

Search or browse for Federal Web sites based on the Government structure found in the *U.S. Government Manual*. Agencies are divided into six categories: executive; judicial; legislative; independent; boards, commissions, and committees; and quasi-official.

The information on **GPO Access** is the official version and in the public domain, unless otherwise noted. **GPO Access** provides free permanent public access to Government information products residing on its servers.
