The World Cultures and History requirement is designed to introduce students to major ideas, institutions, and historical events that have shaped human societies. The courses that would meet this objective have some of the following features: (1) they are designed primarily to explore topics, issues, or themes; (2) they provide an historical perspective (in the sense of addressing the changes in institutions, movements, or cultural practices); (3) they emphasize critical events, movements, institution, ideas, literary/artistic achievements; (4) they present a comparative approach between cultures in the European and non-European tradition, or subcultures within cultures. International Perspective courses may or may not be comparative but should present a view across national cultures. A course may be included in more than one category but students may count a course in only one category.

Writing Intensive *(letter of verification from instructor required; www.tulane.edu/~currcomm/text)*

Students enrolled in writing intensive courses and writing intensive practica must complete a total of 5000 words (approximately 20 pages) which may be one project or several. At least one or more projects totaling 2500 words must be completely revised based on detailed evaluation of the course instructor. Examples: One 20-page paper (5000 words); the entire paper must be completely revised. Two 10-page papers (5000 words); one ten-page paper must be completely revised. Four 5-page papers (5000 words); two five-page papers must be completely revised.
