Chicago born Gladys Freeman married Moise S. Cahn and spent her life in New Orleans working in social welfare and actively for the national Council of Jewish Women, serving as National President 1949-55. Also she held offices in Civil Rights Comm., La Civil Liberties Union, U.N.E.S.C.O., American Cancer Society, La Conference of Social Welfare, and other organizations.

The papers consist of speeches given during the 1950's-1960's mostly to the National Council of Jewish Women and reports of committees and boards.
