Records of the Women's Auxiliary of the New Orleans Chapter of the American Institute of Architects, founded in 1947 and now defunct. Records include minutes of meetings, announcements of activities, photographs and other memorabilia. A majority of the records are in relation to the Beaux Arts Ball, an event held annually to raise money to fund a travel scholarship in the Tulane School of Architecture.

## PROVENANCE

Records were given by the A.I.A. New Orleans Chapter Women's Auxiliary, through Doris LeBreton, a member of the organization, to Tulane in 1988. LeBreton had collected most of the records herself and preserved them as a record of the work of the Auxiliary.
