Drawings by New Orleans architect and educator Nathaniel C. Curtis, Sr. (d.1953). Most of the drawings were made as illustrations for Curtis' book *New Orleans, Its Old Houses, Shops, and Public Buildings* (Philadelphia, 1927). Among the drawings is the original map reproduced as a fold-out insert in the volume. A native of Alabama, Curtis headed the Tulane architecture program during its early years. He was also the principal designer and draughtsman for the New Orleans architectural firm Moise H. Goldstein.
