Biographical information about Frances Porcher Graveley (1855-ca.1930's), New Orleans architect, by Virginia Weaver for a term paper for a Louisiana architecture course in the University College, Tulane University, New Orleans in 1965. Included are photographs of Graveley projects, biographical information, and correspondence. Graveley was architect of several early 20th century commercial buildings and residences. Of note is the 1904 residence at 2037 Napoleon Avenue in New Orleans, which was built for a collector of Japanese art. The house mimics Asian building design, and is known locally as the "pagoda house".
