Records of the office of New Orleans architect Henry W. Krotzer, Jr., and papers concerning his professional career. Krotzer was a partner with the New Orleans architectural firm Koch and Wilson (Richard Koch, 1889-1971); Samuel Wilson, Jr. (1911-1993). He later practiced, and continues to practice, under his own name. Included are project drawings and correspondence done under his name. Also, included are notes made by Krotzer in Paris relative to drawings of Louisiana interest in the French National Archives, and correspondence concerning the Pontalba Papers, a microfilm copy of which is held by the Tulane Manuscripts Department.
