Research material by Newcomb College, Tulane University student Lisa Fischer in 1985 for her senior honors thesis. The subject of her thesis was the Tiffany glass windows at Tulane University. One group of windows was originally part of the chapel on Newcomb's former campus in New Orleans' garden district. Other windows were commissioned for buildings for Tulane University's, then, new campus in the 1890's. The windows are currently used in the current Newcomb chapel, Tilton Hall, and the Newcomb Art Gallery. Included is a copy of Fischer's thesis.
