Records of the Tulane University School of Architecture from about 1912 to 1970's. Included are student drawings, most from 1920's, photographs of classes and faculty, and correspondence. Of special interest is the Gargoyle Collection, a group of photographs (copy prints) showing historic New Orleans buildings. Founded in 1907, Tulane's School of Architecture is one of the oldest and most respected in the southern United States.
