Microfilm copies of the *Vieux Carre Survey*, a comprehensive survey of the French Quarter in New Orleans. The survey was sponsored by the Tulane School of Architecture under a grant from the Scheider Foundation of New Orleans, and done during the 1960's. The survey was headquartered at 520 Royal Street, now the Historic New Orleans Collection, which had been offered for the purpose by the owner, L. Kemper Williams. It was decided to keep the original survey at Williams' residence, which was being developed into the Historic New Orleans Collection, and microfilm copies would be available at Tulane. The survey includes chain of title, narrative data, and photographs for each property in the French Quarter. The survey was never completely finished, leaving some addresses unrecorded in the final hard copy. Information not in the microfilm copies may be found with the survey at the Historic New Orleans Collection.

PROVENANCE

Microfilm copies were transferred from the Historic New Orleans Collection to Tulane in 1968.
