Drawings by Henry W. Baird (d.1959) of New Orleans. Drawings are designs for interior decoration and furniture, both domestic and commercial, executed in pencil, ink, and watercolor. Baird moved to New Orleans ca. 1919 from the mid-western United States. The drawings were supposedly done during an apprenticeship or study in Chicago. Baird is not known to have practiced interior decoration in New Orleans. Drawings were bound in a sketchbook and unbound after being given to Tulane.
