REPORT.

To the Honorable the Senate and
House of Representatives of the State of Louisiana:

In compliance with law the Board of Administrators of the Charity Hospital respectfully present their annual report:

The clerk's statement exhibits that the number of patients admitted during the year 1869, was 6177; discharged, 5327; died, 784—being an increase of 1196 patients over the number treated the previous year, though in 1867 the number reached 8612.

The Board has under its charge not only the main hospital, but the United States Marine Hospital, which was until the past year occupied by the Freedmen's Bureau, as a hospital. The building and patients were, however, turned over to this institution in the month of June. The United States Government placed the Marine Hospital building under the control of the Charity Hospital, without any expense to the institution. The additional expense attending the reception and care of the Bureau patients was great, and was not adequately met by the appropriation of five thousand dollars by the last General Assembly.

The total cost of sustaining this noble institution for the ensuing year, judging from the past, will approximate \$130,000. There are debts amounting to \$19,860, which should be provided for.

The amount received the past year from the United States for the Merchants' Marine patients was \$29,234. It will not exceed that amount this year, if continued, though the government may see fit to withdraw the marine patients at any time.

Heretofore the institution has received some assistance from the tax on foreign passengers, but the Legislature, at the last session,

diverted the fund to the Bureau of Emigration. In 1867 the tax on lotteries yielded \$33,035 48. This source of revenue has also been diverted, and is now paid to the fund for Public Education. By reference to the Treasurer's report it will be seen that the total receipts from other sources are not in excess of \$5,000.

Thus it appears, estimating \$30,000 to be received from the United States for marine patients, that there will be a deficit for the next year of \$95,000, which must be provided for.

We feel that it will only be necessary for us to make this statement in order to receive at the hands of the Legislature of the State the necessary appropriation. The promptitude with which the State has ever assisted this noble charity reflects credit upon our people. We trust that the present management of the institution has deserved the credit which has been accorded to those who have controlled it in the past.

We will not presume to suggest how the fund shall be raised. Whether the laws levying special licenses and taxes for the Charity Hospital should be re-enacted, or whether the amount necessary to meet the deficiency should be appropriated out of the general funds of the State, is a question for the Legislature to determine.

We cannot omit to refer to the noble work of the Sisters of Charity among the sick and suffering poor who have been received and cared for in this hospital. Like angels of mercy, they have ever been watchful and tender in their attentions.

The officers of the institution have been faithful, and have given satisfaction.

Dr. A. W. Smyth, House Surgeon, has been untiring in his devotion to his profession. His world wide reputation as a surgeon has reflected the highest credit upon the institution.

The Assistant Surgeon, Dr. J. A. Root, Dr. W. H. Hire, the Treasurer and Secretary, and the other officers, have been zealous and punctual in the discharge of their various duties.

In conclusion, the Board of Administrators commend the wise and noble charity which has been so long the pride and credit of the State to a continuation of the favorable attention which it has hitherto received from the Legislature.
