# RULING ON JUDICIAL REVIEW

This matter came before the Court on the 28th day of August, 2017 on the Plaintiff's Petition For Judicial Review of the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality's decision granting the issuance of Air Permit No. 1740-00076-00 to Southern Aggregates, LLC. After argument of counsel, the court took the matter under advisement.

No evidence outside of the administrative record was considered by the trial court.

On September 27, 2016, The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality issued the permit in question to Southern Aggregates after the department argued it appropriately performed its obligations as the public trustee of the environment and in accordance with law. Shortly thereafter, the plaintiffs filed this judicial review of that decision on November 18, 2016 claiming that the department failed to uphold its duty as public trustee because, among other reasons, to fully determine that all adverse impacts on the environment have been minimized or avoided as much as possible consistent with the public welfare.

This Court, having considered the briefings of counsel, argument of counsel, and the administrative record finds that the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality failed as public trustee of the environment as required by law. Specifically, the court finds that the decision of the department is not supported and not sustainable by a preponderance of the evidence that the department upheld its public trustee duty by failing to weigh the cost to the neighboring landowners in the Oak Hills Community as required by law when performing its environmental cost analysis. The department's conclusion that the social and economic benefits of this permit significantly outweighed the environmental impact cost cannot be supported without determination of the economic impact the project will or may have upon neighboring landowners.



Accordingly, the court orders that the decision of the department to issue Air Permit No. 1740-00076-00 to Southern Aggregates, LLC be vacated and pursuant to the provisions of La. R.S. 49:964 this court remands this matter back to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality for further proceedings, to include, a thorough cost benefit analysis and determination of the environmental impact cost to the neighboring property owners in the Oak Hills Community.

A judgment shall be submitted in consistent with this ruling in accordance with Uniform Rule 9.5. Each party is to bear their own respective cost of this proceeding.
