Tulane's School of Continuing Studies (SCS) offers an excellent opportunity for recent high-school graduates to continue their education as part-time students at Tulane University. With multiple campus locations (Uptown New Orleans, Elmwood in Harahan, and Biloxi, MS), and daytime, evening, weekend, and online courses, SCS is flexible and student-centered. **JUST THE FACTS;
ADMISSION, TUITION & FINANCIAL AID**

- **Open Admission:** SCS's open admission policy makes it easy for students to enroll with a high-school diploma or GED, 1-page application, and \$25 application fee. No high school or college transcripts are needed at the time of application, and no standardized test scores are required. SCS has no application deadlines; students may apply year-round for the fall, spring, and summer semesters.
- **Earn Up to 13 Credits Per Semester:** Although students enrolled in SCS are classified as part-time, they may earn up to 13 credits each semester. (Most SCS courses are three credits). This 13-credit maximum may qualify students for continued coverage

on parental health insurance policies and other such benefits available to students who earn 12 or more credits in a semester.

- **Affordable Tuition:** For the 2006-07 academic year, tuition for SCS classes is \$255 per credit hour, or \$765 for a three-credit course. Courses offered by other undergraduate schools at Tulane are open to SCS students, but these courses are not billed at the reduced SCS rate.
- **Financial Aid & TOPS:** Federal financial aid is available to qualified part-time students. Eligible SCS students who enroll for at least 12 credits per semester can also participate in the Louisiana Tuition Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS).

CUTTING-EDGE & CONVENIENT: DEGREES, LOCATIONS & SCHEDULES

- **Degree Programs in a Variety of Fields:** Students may earn two-year and four-year degrees, as well as certificates, in a variety of fields, including business studies, applied computing systems and technology, casino resort studies, general studies, journalism, media arts, paralegal studies, social sciences, and other majors in the liberal arts and sciences. Faculty are real-world practitioners who bring a mixture of practical experience and scholarly knowledge into the classroom.
- **Convenient Campuses:** In addition to attending class on the historic main campus in Uptown New Orleans, students may take courses at the Elmwood campus in Harahan (800 E. Commerce Rd., Suite 100) or in Biloxi (2600 Beach Boulevard, Suite 18).
- **Flexible Schedules:** SCS courses are offered during the day, in the evening (when most classes meet once a week), or on weekends. Online courses provide even more scheduling flexibility.

BE A PART OF THE TULANE COMMUNITY

- **An Active Campus:** SCS students participate in a full range of traditional collegiate activities and services, including tutoring, educational testing and support services, career planning and placement, student interest organizations, student government, and much more.
- **On-Campus Housing:** Part-time students may live in student housing on the Uptown campus. Campus housing accommodates SCS students on a space-available basis.
- **Option to Apply for Full-Time Status:** SCS students may apply to the full-time undergraduate division of Tulane after successfully completing a certain number of credits. Students interested in a possible transfer to the full-time division should consult an adviser to plan their course selections carefully.
