ADMISSION & ENROLLMENT

Tulane enrolls part-time students year-round for the fall, spring, and summer semesters. The open admissions policy makes it easy to become a student. Requirements for admission include a high-school diploma or GED, a one-page application, and a \$25 fee. Standardized test scores and transcripts are not required. Apply in person or by mailing in a printed application form and application fee, or apply online at www.scs.tulane.edu. Federal financial aid is available to qualified students.

CAMPUS FACILITIES AND SERVICES

The Mississippi Coast Campus features state-of-the-art multimedia classrooms and computer laboratories, as well as office space for faculty and staff. Academic advising is available on-site. Wireless Internet access is available throughout the campus. Books and other materials from Tulane's Howard-Tilton Memorial Library in New Orleans are provided to students via courier.
