To the Applicant: The Emily Schoenbaum Research and Community Development Grants Program seeks to encourage and support projects that will benefit the lives of women and girls, particularly those in New Orleans area. Individuals or nonprofit, IRS tax-exempt institutions and organizations in Louisiana are eligible to apply. Applicants may be students, faculty or staff members of any Louisiana college, university, primary or secondary school, as well as community scholars and activists. Grants of up to \$1,000 will be awarded for project related costs.

THE APPLICATION DEADLINE IS FRIDAY 9 MARCH 2007.

Your proposal should include: 1) The completed application form; 2) a project statement describing the purpose of your project and the methodology, a time-line for project completion, and the relationship of the project to the Program goals (not to exceed three pages); 3) a budget statement itemizing and explaining research expenses; and 4) a letter of support from someone familiar with your project.
