



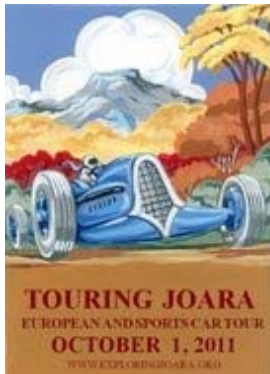

Join the Exploring Joara Foundation on a European and Sports Car Tour and discover the scenic views of beautiful curving mountain roads passing through rich historical landscape!

Joara is the name of the Native American village where the Spanish Captain, Juan Pardo, built Fort San Juan in 1587 making it the earliest European settlement in the interior of the United States. On the tour you will visit the Derry site where archaeologists have uncovered the remains of Joara and Fort San Juan.
